## Anderson Windows

Many employees in any industry do not completely understand their benefit packages available to them. Over the next few issues, we will take

a closer look at the different benefits active and retired clergy have available to them. This issue we will look at the **Comprehensive Protection Plan (CPP)**.

CPP is the “death and disability” plan for clergy in The United Methodist Church. Both active and retired clergy may be eligible for benefits. Three different benefits are included in CPP:

- 1) Death benefit for active clergy, retired clergy, spouse, surviving spouse, and depend children under age 19
- 2) Supplemental benefits for surviving spouses
- 3) Long-term disability benefits

### Eligibility

To be eligible for CPP, active clergy must be **serving full-time appointment** (local pastor or clergy) and the local charge pays 3% of compensation for CPP benefits. If a person is serving an extension ministry, an agreement must be made between the employer and **the clergy person- Wespath**.

Retired clergy are eligible for the death benefit if:

- Was eligible to receive a benefit from CRSP at the time of retirement **OR**
- Retired at age 62 or served 30 years of service **AND IN EITHER CASE**
- Served any of the 12 out of 15 years immediately preceding retirement or a total of 25 years in CPP.

A spouse's and/or surviving spouse's eligibility is based on the clergy's eligibility.

Any questions on eligibility needs to be directed to Wespath at 800-851-2201.

### Death Benefit

The death benefit is different for active clergy and retired clergy, but both categories has benefits for the clergy person, spouses, surviving spouses, and dependent children. Many of the benefits are a percentage of the Denominational Average Compensation (DAC). The benefits are listed in the chart below:

Annual Surviving Spouse Benefit	\$15,114 less the annuity benefit from CRSP	N/A	N/A
Annual Surviving child benefit – ages 17 and younger	10% of DAC (for 2022: \$7,557)	10% of DAC (for 2022: \$)	10% of DAC (for 2022: \$)
Annual Surviving Child Educational Benefits (ages 18-24, full-time student)	20% of DAC (for 2022: \$15,114)	20% of DAC (for 2022: \$15,114)	20% of DAC (for 2022: \$15,114)

All of the death benefits are tax free to the beneficiaries and are typically paid in one-time payments. Generally, the supplement benefits may be taxable. Be sure to check with your tax advisor.

### Supplemental Benefit for Surviving Spouses

If an active clergy dies, there is a Supplemental Benefit for the Surviving Spouse as well as benefits for children under age 19 and educational benefits until age 24.

The Supplemental Benefit for the surviving spouse is 20% of DAC (for 2022: \$15,114). However, this benefit is reduced by annuity benefit payable from the CRSP Plan. In other words, typically, the maximum benefit for a surviving spouse will be \$15,114, payable in monthly installments. In addition to this, the surviving spouse will receive the entire balance of the defined contribution accounts (cash-value accounts).

For each surviving child under age 18, the surviving spouse will also receive 10% of DAC (for 2022: \$7,557) in monthly installments. Surviving children attending school full-time, may receive 20% of DAC (for 2022: \$15,114) payable in monthly installments.

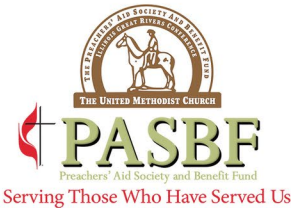
### Long-term Disability Benefits

If a participating clergy is deemed to be disabled, CPP will pay a benefit of 70% of plan compensation for the plan year in which the first payment is effective. The maximum benefit is capped at 200% of DAC. The clergy person must be declared disabled by a physician.

The benefit is coordinated with Social Security benefits. This means the benefit from CPP will be reduced by any benefits paid by Social Security. Keep in mind CPP typically begins to pay benefits sooner than Social Security. You may begin to receive the full 70% from CPP. If you are disabled by Social Se-

curity, you will receive a lump sum of accrued benefits, and you are responsible to reimburse the plan for Social Security's portion.

Participants receiving CPP benefits may also be eligible to receive retirement plan contributions to either CRSP or UMPIP. Disabled clergy may continue to receive service year credit while on CPP as well as receive a 2% contribution of total compensation to your defined contribution

account. In addition, the participant may receive the 1% match to UMPIP based on the participant's contributions to UMPIP.

For those not eligible for CRSP but eligible for UMPIP, the participant may receive a contribution to UMPIP by CPP of 3% of total compensation.

If a person on disability is able to return to work, CPP has a Return-to-Work Program designed to assist with the transition.

Generally, CPP disability benefits are taxable income as the participant did not pay the premiums. Be sure to check with your tax advisor.

As you can see, the Comprehensive Protection Plan is quite extensive with many different components. While it is a rich plan and a great start, additional life insurance may be needed to replace lost wages and care for the family. Talk with your Ernest & Young, your financial planner, or myself to make sure your needs are met.

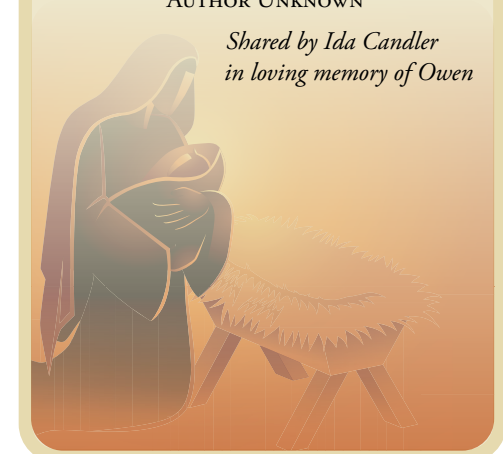

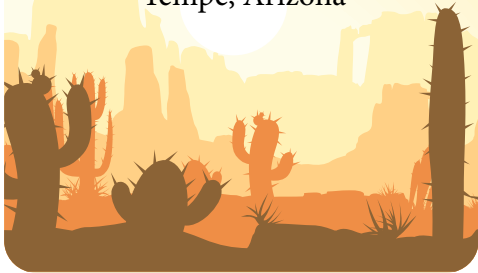

## New Year Resolutions for Finances

The New Year is a good time to evaluate and re-evaluate your financial goals and to make resolutions on how to improve your financial position. Here are some thoughts/suggestions as you consider your financial goals for 2022.

### 1) Set Long-term and Short-term Goals

Any financial plan begins with goals. What are your goals in retirement? Do you want to own a home or rent or live with your kids? Each carries its own financial liabilities and it makes a difference on how much you need to save.

But, do not just focus on your long-term goals. Establish some short-term goals. Is there a major item you want to purchase in the next 6-12 months? Do you want to be more consistent with your budget? Where do you want to go on vacation this year? Have short-term goals that you can accomplish and feel good about. This will build momentum in your financial plan.

### 2) Discover Where Your Money Went

Too many times we wonder where our money went versus telling it where to go. Identify all your expenses for the last few months. Was each expense really needed, or could you give up one or more expenses in the coming year? Be honest with yourself and your spouse as you make decisions on your wants and needs for the coming year. And then make a plan – a budget – on how you will spend your money.

### 3) Pay Down Debt

Pay down your debt as quickly as you can. Imagine keeping the amount you pay for a car each month. What would you do with that money? Make a plan to eliminate your debt as fast as you can. Dave Ramsey's debt snowball is a highly effective way to get out of debt.

### 4) Update Your Insurance Needs

Analyze your insurance needs. You may have made a purchase this past year that you need to insure. If you updated your home, you may need to adjust the insurance. Talk with your insurance agent and don't be afraid to ask where you can reduce the cost for insurance. Typically, insurance companies offer significant discounts if you have all your policies with one company. And do not be afraid to shop around and get bids. You may encounter some great savings.

### 5) Revisit Your Investment Strategy

Not only should you rebalance your investment funds every year but it may be a good time to also step back and examine your investment strategy. Not only are you one year closer to retirement but you are one year close to your death. While you may not want to face it, but our time is limited. Making or reviewing your estate plans can be invaluable to your children and grandchildren. Make sure you have all your assets and liabilities listed somewhere a **trusted heir** can find them. Make sure you update addresses of beneficiaries. Evaluate what you want to leave to family and friends versus to charities. Have you talked to the person who will serve as executor of your estate, sharing your wishes with him/her? Do you have a living will as well as end of life directives? Have you shared them with your loved ones? Beginning the new year having your estate plans set can give you peace of mind for the coming year.

Most of us are highly motivated at the beginning of a new year to make changes and plans. Take advantage of that motivation to set yourself up for a successful year.

And if you are one to itemize your deductions, collect and organize those documents now. It will make tax preparation so much easier for you or your tax preparer.

I would also advise everyone to double check their will; any beneficiaries to your will, IRA, life insurance, etc; and update them all. Doing it during the winter months puts your mind at ease and enables you to enjoy the weather of spring and summer.
