During the pandemic, the Board of Directors of Preachers' Aid Society and Benefit Fund did something new – we did strategic planning via

Zoom. We were hesitant on how it would turn out without physically being in the same space, but we discovered it was exciting, rewarding, and very beneficial.

The planning was directed by Experience Makes the Difference (EMD) out of St. Louis. Over a series of several meetings and months, EMD lead the Board to analyze the past, reflect on the present, and strategically envision PASBF's future.

The following four strategic priorities emerged from our time:

- Respond to changes within The United Methodist Church General Conference and modify organizational structure as necessary to allow us to continue ministry to and for the benefit of clergy and clergy families currently affiliated with the Illinois Great Rivers Conference.
- 2. Expand services that support the social connectedness, financial stability, and health of retirees, spouses, and surviving spouses.
- 3. Expand services that help active clergy prepare for a financially stable retirement.
- 4. Implement a staffing structure that supports effective and efficient services.

Let me elaborate on these priorities.

#### **Responding to Changes**

We realize the UMC is currently fractured and will more than likely split. The delays in General Conference had initially brought hope for healing but have instead broadened the fissures in our denomination. There is a lot of uncertainty right know on how things will look in the next few years.

The Board has maintained and continues to state our desire to continue to serve all the clergy and families we are currently serving. As the Board stated in our Resolution that was also approved by the Annual Conference, it is PASBF's plan to serve our current retirees and active clergy in the IGRC at the time of any formal separation, and they continue to serve in a denomination that is served by Wespath.

I do want to be clear, however; if a person or church leaves the conference now, they are jeopardizing the benefits of PASBF. This is current with our current policy. Anyone who turns in their credentials, transfers out of the IGRC, or does not retire from the IGRC does not receive benefits.

There will be many more decisions to be made for specific situations, but the Board is clear our intention is to serve all the clergy – and families – we are currently serving.

#### **Primary Focus on Retirees**

The primary focus of PASBF continues to be on retired clergy. Our original mission statement over 150 years ago said Preachers' Aid is to "serve the tired and worn out clergy of the conference." While the way we fulfill our mission has changed, the mission itself has never changed. When looking at the ministries we offer, an overwhelming amount focus has been on retirees and spouses. That will not change.

The ministries we offer attempt to focus on the following areas: 1) Advocacy, 2) Spiritual, 3) Fellowship, 4) Financial, and 5) Wellness. PASBF partners with the Conference to try and meet the needs of our retirees and spouses in all aspects of life. PASBF is constantly evaluating and re-evaluating our ministries in an attempt to do the best we can.

#### **Supporting Active Clergy**

The Board also realizes strong pastoral leadership and strong local churches help PASBF to remain strong. To this end, PASBF will be reaching out to support our active clergy and local churches.

Ministry is not an easy profession, and it carries many stressors. The last few years have been extremely difficult for active clergy. Many – maybe even most – are exhausted and on the verge of burnout. We all are concerned for our clergy and the future of the church.

In the coming next few years, PASBF will be offering and sponsoring different training events to support and strengthen our clergy and churches. We will be intentionally reaching out to offer workshops, podcasts, and seminars to help active clergy not only prepare for retirement but also improve their leadership skills.

We also want to connect with active clergy in a way to join in ministering to our retired clergy and families. Our desire is to open up communication lines with local churches and pastors. There have been times when we were unaware a retiree was hospitalized and vice versa. It is our hope to be in partnership in caring for the retirees and spouses.

### **Staffing**

Our final priority is looking at staffing. It has been some time since we stepped back and examined our current staffing structure. Our current staff members are all excellent. They do an amazing job for us.

The question we have been asking is how do we structure the organization to perform at its best? We have been analyzing how many staff we need to accomplish our priorities and where do they need to be "deployed." We are also examining each job description to realign the positions and make the descriptions more accurate.

#### **Conclusion**

I am really excited about the direction PASBF is headed. We will not accomplish all of this overnight and there will be many bumps, valleys, hills, and peaks ahead. But I am confident we will succeed in *Serving Those Who Have Served Us First*.






### **Leading Through Crisis**

Clergy are facing more crises than ever before. In the UMC, clergy have not only been dealing with the pandemic but also a future split of the denomination. These are but two crises that many clergy face as each church has had its own crises to deal with.

Participants discussed and discovered ways to work through a crisis instead of letting a crisis work on you. The event occurred on Zoom with the participants learning from each other as well.

Look for future events as PASBF seeks to empower active clergy.



### **Medicare Open Window**

Medicare's Open Window is October 15-December 7 every year. This is your opportunity to switch a Medicare Health Plan and/or Drug Plan. We strongly encourage everyone to review and compare their plans to ensure you have the best fit. This goes for Medicare Part D Plans, Medicare Gap (Supplement) Plans, and Advantage (All-in-One) Plans.

If you are on the Conference's Health Plan for Retirees, your Medicare Supplement is through the conference. This is an Employer Sponsored Plan, which means it is illegal for telemarketers to sell you a different plan. If you do choose to leave the plan, you will not be able to return to the Conference Plan.

#### **Medicare Part D**

Illinois will have a total of 23 plans in 2022, down from 29 plans in 2021. The monthly premiums for the Part D Plans range from \$6.90 per month to \$94.30. While the premium range is lower than in 2021, there is a significant decline in the least monthly plans. For 2022, there are only three

plans at or below \$20/month and five at or below \$25/month compared to six and 14 plans in 2021.

#### 2022 Auto Enroll

A total of eight plans are discontinued in Illinois with only two new plans. When I plan is discontinued, the company will make arrangements for you to be automatically enrolled in a different plan. However, if you have one of the plans, you should do a review and compare. The chart below lists the discontinued plans and the auto transfer plans.
